The Institute of Systematics and Evolution of Animals PAS has the pleasure to host the "22nd Annual Meeting of the European Association of Vertebrate Palaeontologists (EAVP)". The Meeting will be held at the Krzysztofory Palace of the Museum of Kraków and the Museum of Natural History ISEA PAS.

Scope of the meeting is the presentation of novel palaeontological research by scientists and students from all over Europe (but also from other continents). Such presentations will cover a rather wide spectrum of Vertebrate Palaeontology, spanning across a variety of fossil animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals), and encompassing systematics, evolution, morphology, taphonomy, biogeography, and application of novel technologies in the fossil record.

Several full days of scientific presentations on the latest and exciting research finds and discoveries, three different field trips in fossil localities, various workshops on palaeontological techniques, will render Krakow as the epicenter of Palaeontology in the summer of 2025.
